Divulgarti, born in Genoa in 2015 from an idea of Loredana Trestin - gallery owner and curator - operates through cultural proposal, primarily by organizing art exhibitions of contemporary artists in places rich in cultural history and prestige, such as Palazzo Ducale and Palazzo Saluzzo dei Rolli in Genoa, or Palazzo Zenobio in Venice, home of the Biennale d'Arte, or in the atelier of Via Monte Napoleone in Milan and other national locations. The exhibitions and cultural initiatives are accompanied by meetings, conferences, seminars, aperitifs with the author, small shows, to combine art with the themes of debate and cultural deepening. It often promotes the encounter between art and business, in the space dedicated to the exhibition of companies, design studios, artisans, fashion houses in a context reserved for art, as well as the meeting between artists and the world of school, through workshops for children and young people and inserting young students in a pretrial path in different sectors for the organization of exhibitions and art events.
